English Study

Kiwi English Academy is located in Newmarket, a trendy up-market area of Auckland city. The classes are designed to be fun while learning, using games and computers as part of the lesson. A structured approach to reading and writing, listening and conversational skills ensures that you will maximize your learning opportunities.

Floristry

2 Weeks - Introductory Floristry Programme Students study General English (Part time) at Kiwi English Academy and the theory and practice of floristry 10 hours per week (Mon-Fri 2-4pm) at HANA Club Mangere Bridge where instruction is given by a qualified tutor.

3 Weeks - Florist Experience Programme The same as above plus during the second 2 weeks of the programme, students do a voluntary experience at a local florist, putting into practice both their English and their floristry skills.

6 Weeks - Flower Designer Programme The programme combines 4 weeks of General English (Part time) at Kiwi English Academy and the theory and practice of floristry (Mon-Fri 2-4 pm). The final two weeks of the programme involve a voluntary experience at a local florist.

Frequently Asked Questions

Q. What happens on the first day?

A. You will be taken to a floristry lesson venue by Kiwi English staff. You will also be shown the bus stops to get on/off.

Q. How to get to my placement?

A. You will need to catch a bus. Your tutor will give you the bus information.

Q. What do I need to bring to the floristry practice?

A. Nothing to bring to the floristry lesson. All the resource fees are included.

Q. What are the work hours for internship?

A. Up to 8 hours per day. No work on weekends.

Q. Do I need to have special skills to work at Flower shop?

A. You will learn the basic skills to work at flower shop from your tutor in the first 2 weeks.
