Programme Features

We offer a structured programme that includes General English plus subject-specific study when students have reached a certain level.

Through the NZQA (New Zealand Qualifications Authority), we are accredited to teach NCEA (National Certificate in Educational Achievement) achievement standards in English, Science, Maths, Accounting and Economic Theory and Practice. Kiwi English Academy is one of the few English language schools in NZ accredited to offer these NCEA achievement standards, and the only school in central Auckland with this capability.

We provide a caring, disciplined environment where students are able to adjust academically, socially and personally to their new life in New Zealand.

Our junior programme attracts students from many different countries, including South America, China, Hong Kong, Japan, Korea, New Caledonia, Tahiti, Russia, Taiwan, Turkey, and Vietnam. Students have the opportunity to make friends from around the world.



Programme Length



The length of the programme depends on the student's level at the time of entry into Kiwi English Academy.

Recommended English levels on entry to high school are:

- Year 9 low pre-intermediate (A2+) Year 10 pre-intermediate (A2)


- Year 11 intermediate (B1) Year 12 upper intermediate (B2)

- -> Commences every Monday
